## Advanced Trainee in Nuclear Medicine and PET

South Coast Radiology is pleased to offer an accredited training position in Nuclear Medicine and PET in 2018. South Coast Radiology consists of 22 Radiologists and Nuclear Medicine Specialists networked across 13 sites located throughout the Gold Coast, Tweed, Toowoomba and Mackay districts, and provides a comprehensive Nuclear Medicine and PET/CT service on the Gold Coast.

General Nuclear Medicine services are based at John Flynn and Pindara Private Hospitals, and the PET/CT facility (which also includes access to Ga-68 DOTATATE and PSMA) is located in Southport. The advanced trainee will be rotated through both hospital sites, and will also have an opportunity to engage in regular reporting of PET/CT. South Coast Radiology works closely with its referrers, and participates in regular multidisciplinary meetings. The advanced trainee will be given opportunity to play an active role in these meetings, and there will be scope to engage in continuing research through South Coast Radiology and its referrers.

Eligibility criteria include:

- AHPRA registration
- Completion of FRANZCR Part II or FRACP Part I exams; currently in training program of RANZCR or RACP, respectively

FRANZCR trainees who have completed five years of RANZCR accredited training and FRACP trainees who have completed their core years of Nuclear Medicine training will be employed as a Fellow. Eligible trainees who have not yet completed such training will be employed as a Senior Registrar.
